Certified Hand Therapy

Patients with problems of the hand, wrist, elbow and shoulder may benefit from the care of a certified hand therapist.

Who may benefit from certified hand therapy?

A certified hand therapist treats conditions affecting not only the hands, but also the upper extremities. Patients who may benefit from specialized hand therapy services include:

- those affected by an accident or trauma, suffer from conditions such as carpal tunnel syndrome or tennis elbow, or cope with chronic problems such as arthritis or a neurological conditions like stroke.
- surgical patients, including those who have required amputation.
- those who have experienced conditions such as injuries to the fingernail bed, certain chronic pain conditions, lymphedema resulting from cancer surgery or radiation therapy, or tumors or cysts.
- Saint Anne's Hospital's certified hand therapy services are available for both children and adults.

What is a certified hand therapist?

A certified hand therapist is an occupational or physical therapist who has a minimum of five years of clinical experience, including 4,000 hours of direct practice in hand therapy. In addition, they have successfully taken a comprehensive test of advanced clinical skills and theory and must be recertified every five years.

What does certified hand therapy offer?

- rehabilitation after surgery or injury to the upper extremity
- desensitization following nerve injury or trauma
- sensory re-education after nerve injury
- design and implementation of exercise programs to increase motion, dexterity, and/or strength
- splint fabrication for prevention of injury
- training in the performance of daily life skills through updated methods and equipment
- conditioning prior to returning to work

Saint Anne's Hospital's certified hand therapists help patients of all ages — from children through older adults — get back to doing what they love to do.
