Program Overview

The Neurology Medicine Program is primarily located at Palmetto General Hospital in Hialeah, FL. Each rotation is one month in length over four years, with one year being primarily Internal Medicine. Throughout the duration of the program, residents will complete one half-day a week of continuity clinic experience; thus, exposing them to a diverse patient panel. Residents will complete at least 40 half-day sessions of continuity clinic per year throughout their training and be immersed in several disciplines of Neurology.

Required Rotations

During the first year of the program, neurology residents will primarily work with an internal medicine attending, with exposure in emergency medicine. Residents will begin their rotations for inpatient neurology with our core faculty. Palmetto General Hospital's neurology attending will be the primary care provider when neurology-related patients arrive to the hospital. The resident will work alongside the attending and his/her team for admission, discharge, writing orders, and follow-up for the patient for their required inpatient rotation. For Neuro-consults, the attending and resident will provide guidance to other primary services separate from inpatient neurology patients on their service. Continuity Clinic will occur at either the clinical office of Dr. Jose Simon Canellas at Simon Neurology Clinic, Roberto E. Sanchez Neurology Office, or Ariol Labrada MD PA. Once assigned, the resident will complete their 40 half-day sessions of continuity clinic per year throughout their training from PGY 2-4. At least three months of the outpatient experience will be outside the longitudinal/continuity clinic.

Electives

All residents (PGY 1-4) will be allowed to take vacation days during their elective rotation months and on specific core rotations upon approval of the Program Director.

1** PGY 1 IM. PGY 1 residents can select one (1) IM rotation at Palmetto General Hospital, only. The IM rotations offered at PGH include Inpatient Medicine or Emergency Medicine.

PGY 1 residents can select an elective from sites 1-3, only. The electives offered include Neuroimaging, Infectious Disease, NCCU, Pain Management, or Outpatient Clinic.

PGY 2-4 residents can select electives from sites 1-7. These residents may select from a list of clinical experiences on either the inpatient or outpatient setting. Electives include EEG, EMG, Psychiatry, Child Neurology, Neuroimaging, Neuro-ophthalmology, Pain Management, Neuropathology, Neuromuscular, Infectious Disease, NICU, Neurogenetics, Neuropsychology, Interventional Neurology, Outpatient Clinic, Sleep Disorders Clinic, Movement Clinic, Vascular Clinic and Research.
