- Any related lab or pathology results that you have had done outside of St. Elizabeth's.
- All insurance cards.
- An insurance referral or authorization (if required by your insurance company).
- Your co-payment

Due to the complexities of different insurances, we ask that you familiarize yourself with your health plan before the appointment. This will enable you to know what things are and are not covered by your plan.

For your convenience, we have enclosed a medical release form for you to fill out and send to your referring physician. This will allow them to send us your medical records.

For your convenience, we have enclosed directions to the hospital and a hospital map. Complimentary valet parking is available at our main entrance.

Directions

From the West

Take the Massachusetts Turnpike (Route 90) East to Exit 17 (Newton-Watertown). Go straight and take the second right onto Park Street, following signs for Brighton. Take the first left onto Tremont Street and follow for approximately one mile until it connects to the right with Washington Street. Continue on Washington Street for approximately one mile to the Medical Center.

From the North

Take I-93 South to the Massachusetts Turnpike (Route 90) West. Follow the Mass Pike to Exit 20 (Brighton-Cambridge). Proceed through the tollbooth and bear left towards Allston/Brighton (Cambridge Street). Follow H signs for approximately 1.5 miles to the Medical Center.

From the South

Take I-93 North to the Massachusetts Turnpike (Route 90) West. Follow the Mass Pike West to Exit 20 (Brighton-Cambridge). Proceed through the tollbooth and bear left towards Allston/Brighton (Cambridge Street). Follow H signs for approximately 1.5 miles to the Medical Center.

From Downtown Boston

Take the Massachusetts Turnpike (Route 90) West. Follow the Mass Pike to Exit 20 (Brighton-Cambridge). Proceed through the tollbooth and bear left towards Allston/Brighton (Cambridge Street). Follow H signs for approximately 1.5 miles to the Medical Center.

Parking Information

On-site parking is available at the Medical Center. Free patient valet parking is available at the Seton, St. Margaret's and Emergency Room entrances.

Via Public Transportation

- **Green Line**
Take a B, C, or D Green Line Train to Kenmore Square Station. Go upstairs to the bus pavilion and take the #57 bus (Watertown Square) to St. Elizabeth's. The bus stops directly across from the Medical Center.
- **Boston College B Train on the Green Line**
Take the B train to Warren Street and Commonwealth Avenue. Walk north to the end of Warren Street. Take a left onto Nevins Street to the main entrance of St. Elizabeth's, or, take a left onto Cambridge Street and enter the Medical Center through the street level entrance.
- **Red Line**
You have two options when taking the Red Line to St. Elizabeth's:
 1. Take the Red Line to Central Square. Go to the bus stop at the corner of Western Avenue and Green Street and take the #64 (Cleveland Circle) bus.
 2. Take the Red Line to Harvard Square. Go the bus stop at the corner of Massachusetts Avenue and Garden Street and take the #86 (Cleveland Circle) bus.
- Both buses stop at the corner of Washington and Market Streets in Brighton Center. Get off at this stop and walk two blocks east on Washington Street to St. Elizabeth's.
- **Express Bus**
