

Visiting Hours and Guidelines:



Two visitors at a time are welcome during the hours of 10:30am and 8pm. Exceptions may be made for end-of-life situations. If you are unable to visit during these hours, accommodations can be made by contacting our unit.

Visitors in the ICU must be 16 years of age or older.

Designated Contact Person:

One person should be the designated contact person. They will be given a 4-digit code to call and get updates on the patient. The staff will also contact this person regarding any significant changes with the patient.

For patient privacy and HIPPA regulations please do not share the 4-digit code. The ICU staff would like to keep consistency in communicating with one designated person.

During your visit:

To respect the privacy of our patients you may be asked to step off the unit during your visit and we will let you return to the unit as soon as possible.



No food or drink may be brought onto the unit.

Unfortunately, flowers are also not permitted on the unit.
