Program Overview

The Vascular Neurology Medicine Program is primarily located at Palmetto General Hospital in Hialeah Florida. Each rotation is 1 month (4 weeks) in length over one year. Throughout the duration of the program, fellow will complete one half-day a week of continuity clinic experience thus exposing them to a diverse patient panel.

Program Participating Sites

- 1- Palmetto General Hospital – Acute inpatient Stroke/Neurocritical Care, Neurointerventional Surgery, Neuroradiology
- 2- St. Catherine's - Neurorehab

Required Rotations:

During the Acute Inpatient Stroke/Neurocritical Care Rotation, Fellows will develop leadership and educational skills on service by working closely with 5 vascular neurology attendings to lead a team of neurology residents, stroke ARNPs, rotators, and medical students. Fellows rotate on a multidisciplinary team including neurologists, intensivists and neurosurgeons. Primary focus would include management of vascular neurology patients, including management of malignant infarction, elevated intracranial pressure, and intraparenchymal and subarachnoid hemorrhage. During the Neurointerventional Surgery Rotation, Fellows will participate in clinical interventional cases with 3 neurointerventionalists and 1 neurointerventional fellow. Primary cases include mechanical thrombectomy for acute ischemic stroke, repair of cerebral aneurysm and vascular malformations, and carotid endarterectomy and stenting.

Electives

For rotations listed as "Elective" on the block schedule, fellow may select from a list of clinical experiences on either the inpatient or outpatient setting. Elective options include: Neuroradiology, Research, Neurorehab. Fellows will be allowed to take vacation days during their elective rotation months and on specific core rotations upon approval of the Program Director.
