Craniosacral and myofascial therapies are gentle hands-on treatments that improve the functioning of the central nervous system, eliminate the negative

effects of stress, strengthen resistance to disease, and enhance overall health.

The craniosacral system consists of the membranes and fluid that surround and protect the brain and spinal cord. It extends from the bones of the cranium (skull, face and mouth) down to the sacrum, or tailbone area. The extremely light touch involved in the application of craniosacral therapy makes it a safe approach for adults, as well as children, infants and newborns with early traumas.

Since this vital system influences the development and performance of the brain and spinal cord, an imbalance or restriction could potentially cause any number of sensory, motor or neurological disabilities

Craniosacral therapy helps to alleviate a range of illness, pain and dysfunction, including:

- · Chronic neck and back pain
- Motor-coordination impairments
- Stress and tension-related problems
- Chronic fatigue
- Orthopedic problems
- Infantile disorders
- Learning disabilities
- · Seizure disorders
- Many other conditions

Craniosacral and myofascial therapies improve the functioning of the central nervous system.

Myofascial therapy addresses dysfunction in the body's complex system of connective tissue. This therapeutic approach results in increased flexibility of the soft tissues.
